**AUTHORIZATION TO TREAT PROPERTY FOR
RED IMPORTED FIRE ANTS (RIFA)**

I authorize the Coachella Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District, an independent special district operating under the Mosquito Abatement and Vector Control District Law (California Health and Safety Code §§ 2000 et seq.) (the "District"), through the District's Coachella Valley Red Imported Fire Ant (RIFA) Program, to treat this property with one or more of the pesticide chemicals listed below, at **no cost** to me for the treatment. These pesticides are not harmful to humans and animals when used according to label instructions. It is safe to occupy areas treated immediately following the application.

- Indoxacarb (Advion, a metabolic inhibitor)
- Methoprene (Extinguish Plus, an insect growth regulator)

**ALL CONTROL PRODUCTS ARE GRANULAR BAITS AND CARRY A SIGNAL WORD
CAUTION – LOW TOXICITY (CATEGORY III)**

CAUTION: The pesticides used in RIFA control could be harmful if swallowed by humans or animals. Contact of skin with pesticides may cause skin irritation. People and pets will not be permitted in the area during the application of the pesticides.

RELEASE

I understand that this signed Authorization form is **valid** from the date of signature until terminated in writing by the signing party or until there is a change in property ownership and the District has received notice of the change in writing. The signing party acknowledges and agrees that he/she will provide (1) the District with notice of sale of the property within five (5) days of said sale and (2) the successor owner with notice of this RIFA Agreement.

By execution below and in consideration of the District's provision of services hereunder, I hereby expressly release the District from any and all liability for personal injury, property damage, or death, that may arise from the use of the materials identified in this document for the control and treatment of infestation and in this regard hereby waive the provisions of California Civil Code Section 1542, which provides and reads as follows.

"A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect or exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."
